


Installing Maintenance Updates v8.x

Open OSAS to the Main Menu


Choose Resource Manager - Installation and Configuration - Install Maintenance Updates



This screen brings up the Product ID key


NOTE: if you have updated your Product ID Key recently and this is not current

Press <Page Down> or click OK





Review what the Build is updating

Press Continue




If you need updates this will come in tagged (and not let you untag it)
